ABOUT

Community Housing Concepts, Inc. (CHC) is a Denverbased non-profit organization dedicated to increasing affordable housing opportunities across the country for low-income individuals, families, seniors and those with disabilities. It strives to create caring communities to strengthen the lives of residents so that they can thrive.

SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

CHC created this educational scholarship program to support you and your family. It is open to residents of all ages. Scholarships are currently awarded once a year to residents living in a Monroe Group, Ltd. managed property who desire to attend or are attending an accredited educational or vocational institution. The scholarship is generally a one-time award up to \$2,500 per person, but CHC may consider renewing a scholarship on a case-by-case basis.

CRITERIA

The recipients will to be selected by the Scholarship Committee according to the following criteria:

- Must have proof of residency and be a resident in good standing at a Monroe Group managed property.
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and provide current transcripts, if applicable, but the scholarship committee will review the circumstances regarding a lower GPA if an explanation is given.
- Be registered or attending an accredited educational or vocational institution.
- Individual scholarships will normally be a one-time award. CHC may consider renewing a scholarship on a case-by-case basis.

- Must fulfill application requirements and submit completed application with all supporting documentation by Monday June 3rd, 2024. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.
- If an applicant does not meet the above criteria they
 may submit an application with a statement explaining
 why they cannot meet the criteria and request CHC to
 waive such requirement(s).

TERMS OF AWARD

CHC requires that all students comply with the terms of the award offered at the time of their acceptance of the scholarship. The tuition scholarship may be awarded directly to the educational institution or it may be used to finance other expenses such as fees, housing, living expenses, or program supplies as approved by CHC. The scholarship is not redeemable for cash. Tuition scholarships are nontransferable. Scholarship recipient(s) must not interrupt their studies; interruption of studies will result in a loss of the scholarship. Scholarship recipient(s) must maintain satisfactory academic progress. Scholarships are valued for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of the award. Scholarship awards may be considered taxable income. Students are responsible for any taxes on scholarship awards. Additional restrictions and requirements may apply.
